## Reminders - Concerns and FAQs

- Changes to the exterior of homes need to go through Board approval, to include roof replacement and paint color changes.
- Please pull hoses off common area grass as well as children's toys and bikes so landscaping can be done without obstructions.

- Wednesdays and Fridays are normal landscaping days.
- Trash bins must be inside single-family homes after trash pickup, or at least removed from the front of the home.
- The Village reminds us to keep garbage and recycling containers on the curb, not in the street.
- It's the law! Dogs must be on a leash;
   Owners must pick up after their dogs.
   (Landscapers will not take care of discarded doggy bags.)
- Looking ahead to winter, we plow after 2 inches of snow. We never start at the same point. Rest assured that all homes and roads will get done, even if yours is not done first.
